

4. Summary and Closure

Pacific Booker Minerals Inc. is developing the Morrison Copper/Gold Project in north-central British Columbia. An integral part of the proposed mine is the construction of the approximately 25 km long Transmission Line from the Bell substation to the Morrison mine site.

Pacific Booker Minerals Inc. has completed twenty-four baseline studies of the physical, biological and social components of the environment enclosing and surrounding the proposed mine site and proposed Transmission Line ROW. The Environmental Assessment application includes details of effects assessments and environmental management plans that will be undertaken during the construction, pre-production, operation and closure phases of the proposed Morrison Copper/Gold mine project. Pertinent details from the Environmental Assessment Application and Baseline Studies have been included in this document, the Transmission Line Management Plan.
