Thank you for your letter of June 5, 2017, responding to the Environmental Assessment Office's (EAO) letter of March 2, 2016 in which the EAO asked whether Solar Alliance Energy Incorporated (Solar) intends to proceed with the Environmental Assessment (EA) of the Wildmare Wind Energy Project (Wildmare). I appreciate your update and understand that Solar wishes to withdraw Wildmare from the EA process.

If you later decide to pursue Wildmare again, you will be required to start the process over with the submission of a new Project Description and associated fees.
