On May 23, 2018, the Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) received a request to amend the existing Environmental Assessment Certificate #E97-01 (EAC) pursuant to Section 19 of the *Environmental Assessment Act* from British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority. The EAC is currently held by Teck Metals Ltd. and British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority for the construction and operation of the Waneta Generating Station Upgrade Project. I am writing to let you know that on May 30, 2018, the EAO accepted the request to transfer the certificate as part of the Amendment Application for review.

The EAO will consider your request to amend the EAC and engage in an assessment of the Amendment Application. Moving forward, Aboriginal groups and key agencies will be invited to participate in a review and assessment of the Amendment Application.
