RE: Warning for Non-Compliance with Condition 26 of Environmental Assessment Certificate # E14-03, Environmental Management Plan

On May 18 to 19, 2023, Compliance and Enforcement Officer Christie Lombardi conducted a field inspection (Inspection) of the Coastal GasLink Pipeline Project (Project) against the requirements of the Environmental Assessment Certificate #E14-03 (Certificate). Based on the site observations and review of information obtained during the Inspection, it was determined that the Certificate Holder, Coastal GasLink Pipeline Ltd. (the Holder), is not compliant with Condition 26 of the Certificate.

Condition 26 requires the Holder to dispose of recyclable materials from workforce accommodations at appropriate recycling yards.

The inspection findings are documented in Inspection Record 20230041_IR001.

The Holder is hereby **WARNED** that the Project is not compliant with Condition 26 of the Certificate. The maximum penalty for failure to comply with an Environmental Assessment Certificate is \$1 000 000 and, on each subsequent conviction, fine of not more than \$2 000 000.

The Environmental Assessment Office Compliance and Enforcement Branch will continue to monitor this issue and may follow-up with further inspections as required. Future or continuing non-compliance may result in additional enforcement action as warranted.
