RE: Warning for Non-Compliance with Order 20230059_OR003 for Environmental Assessment Certificate #M05-02

On September 28, 2023, Compliance and Enforcement Officer Christie Lombardi conducted a field inspection (Inspection), of the Red Chris Porphyry Copper-Gold Mine Project (Project) against the requirements of the Order 2020059_OR003 (Order). Based on the site observations and review of information obtained during the Inspection, it was determined that the Certificate Holder, Newcrest Red Chris Mining Limited (the Holder), is not compliant with clause 2 of the Order.

Clause 2 of the Order requires the Holder to clean up all leaks and spills of hydrocarbons in accordance with the measures set out in the spill prevention and response plan required by Commitment C30, including removing and properly disposing of any hydrocarbon-contaminated soil.

The inspection findings are documented in Inspection Record 20230059_IR002.

The Holder is hereby **WARNED** that the Project is not compliant with Order 20230059_OR003. The maximum penalty for failure to comply with an Environmental Assessment Certificate is \$1 000 000 and, on each subsequent conviction, fine of not more than \$2 000 000.
