On June 15, 2020, the British Columbia Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) received your request to continue the environmental assessment for the proposed West Coast Olefins Ethylene Project (WCOE) under the *Environmental Assessment Act (Act)* (2002), pursuant to Section 78(6) of the *Act* (2018). The EAO confirms that the WCOE project will continue under the *Act* (2002). Your request will be posted shortly to the EAO project information site and communicated to the working group.

Please be aware that pursuant to subsection 78(7) of the *Act* (2018), if the assessment for WCOE is not completed by December 17, 2022, (that is, three years after the *Act* (2018) was brought into force) the assessment must be completed under the *Act* (2018). If this occurs, the Chief Executive Assessment Officer may make an order for additional procedural requirements.
