Dear Matthew White:

I am writing to follow up with the Environmental Assessment Office's letter¹ of March 17, 2022, and your request for an additional 60-day period to undertake meetings and analysis related to caribou for the Sukunka Coal Mine Project (Sukunka).

As 60 days have elapsed since the March 17, 2022 letter, I now grant an additional suspension of up to 60 days pursuant to Section 24(2) of the *Environmental Assessment Act* (2002). At the end of this suspension, the Application Review phase for Sukunka will resume. This date is currently anticipated to be July 15, 2022.
