The Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) has completed its review of the amendment application submitted by Cedar LNG Partners (GP) Ltd. The application requested an amendment to Environmental Assessment Certificate #E23-01 (Certificate) under Section 32 of the *Environmental Assessment Act* (2018) (the Act).

On July 10, 2026, the Acting Deputy Chief Executive Assessment Officer amended the Certificate after considering the Amendment Application, input from participating Indigenous nations, the EAO's and Cedar LNG's issue resolution efforts and results, the purposes of the Act, the existing Certificate conditions, the overall regulatory regime for Cedar, the EAO's Amendment Assessment Report, and the amended Certificate Conditions.

The amendment authorizes the increase in the authorized liquefaction capacity from 400 to 500 million standard cubic feet per day of natural gas and allows for up to 80 workers to be housed on the floating LNG (FLNG) facility.

Attached is the Section 32 Order that amends the Certificate. Additional information, including the EAO's Amendment Assessment Report, is posted to the EAO's Project Information Centre
